

BIOGRAPHY - PROF. DR.-ING. DIRK MÜLLER



Born in 1968, Prof. Dr.-Ing. Dirk Müller started his scientific career after completing his studies in mechanical engineering at RWTH Aachen University and receiving a Bachelor's degree in engineering at Dartmouth College in Hanover, N.H., USA. After completing his doctorate at RWTH Aachen University with a focus on convection and air conditioning, he worked as a process manager for simulation methods in the Research and Development departments at both Robert Bosch GmbH and Behr GmbH.

In 2003, Prof. Dr.-Ing. Müller received an appointment as university professor at the Technical University of Berlin. There, he was head of the Hermann-Rietschel-Institut until 2007 and Chair for the "Building Management Systems" course of studies.

In 2007, Prof. Dr.-Ing. Müller returned to RWTH Aachen University and has since been the head of the Institut für Gebäude- und Raumklimatechnik (Institute for Building Management Systems and Ventilation Technology) there.

For the last few years, Prof. Dr.-Ing. Müller has been closely connected to TROX GmbH as a Member of the Supervisory Board and consultant. In addition to his academic activities, he assumed the Chief Technical Officer position in the Board of Management starting on 5 July 2011. He is responsible for Research & Development and Product Management.
