


In the eastern part of Sao Paulo, in the Morumbi neighborhood, is one of the largest mixed business/residential areas in Brazil.

Arena Pantanal – Cuiabá

It was built in 2010, in Cuiabá, a city with a population of only 554,000 and hence the smallest playing venue. The stadium can accommodate almost 43,000 people but the modular structure allows for the upper parts to be dismantled such that the capacity will eventually be smaller.


